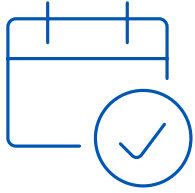

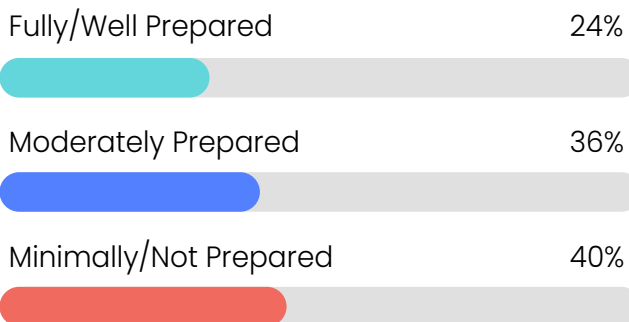

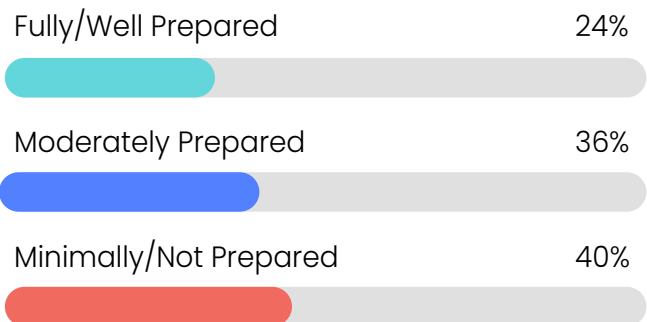

Overall Preparedness Distribution



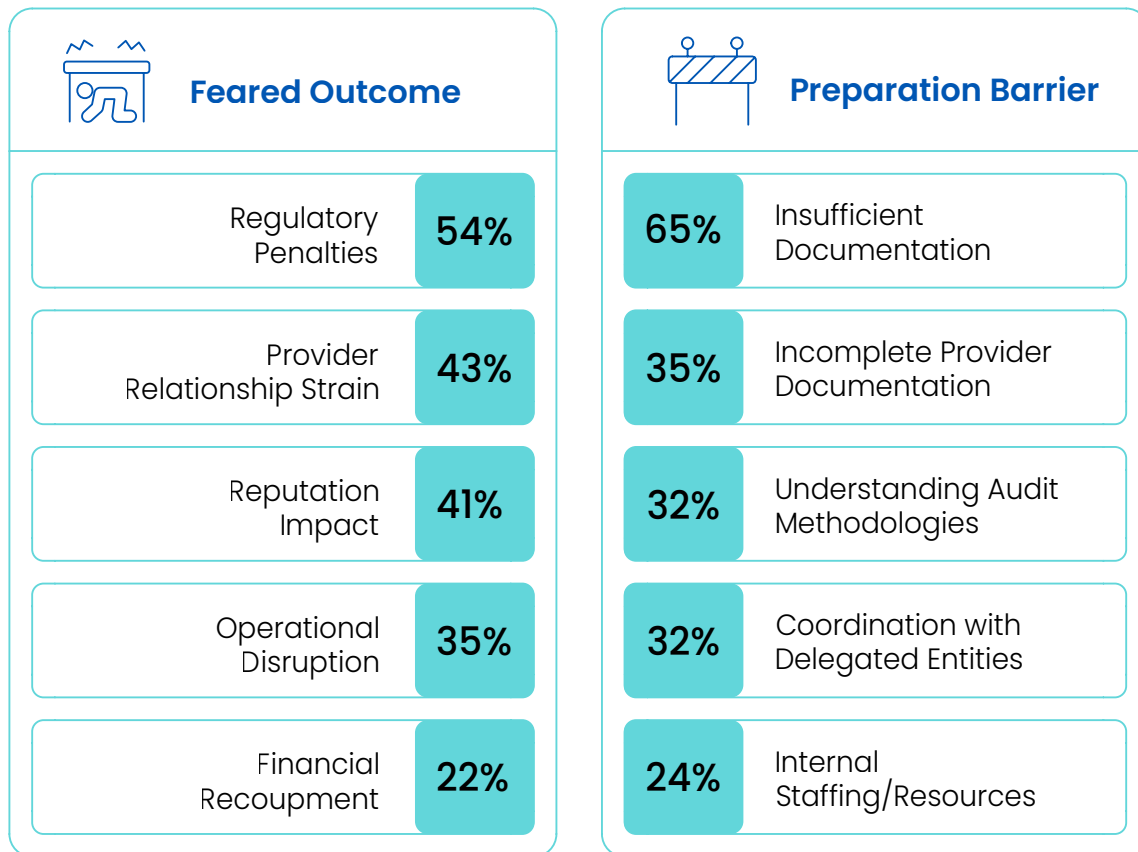
Confidence in Current Practices



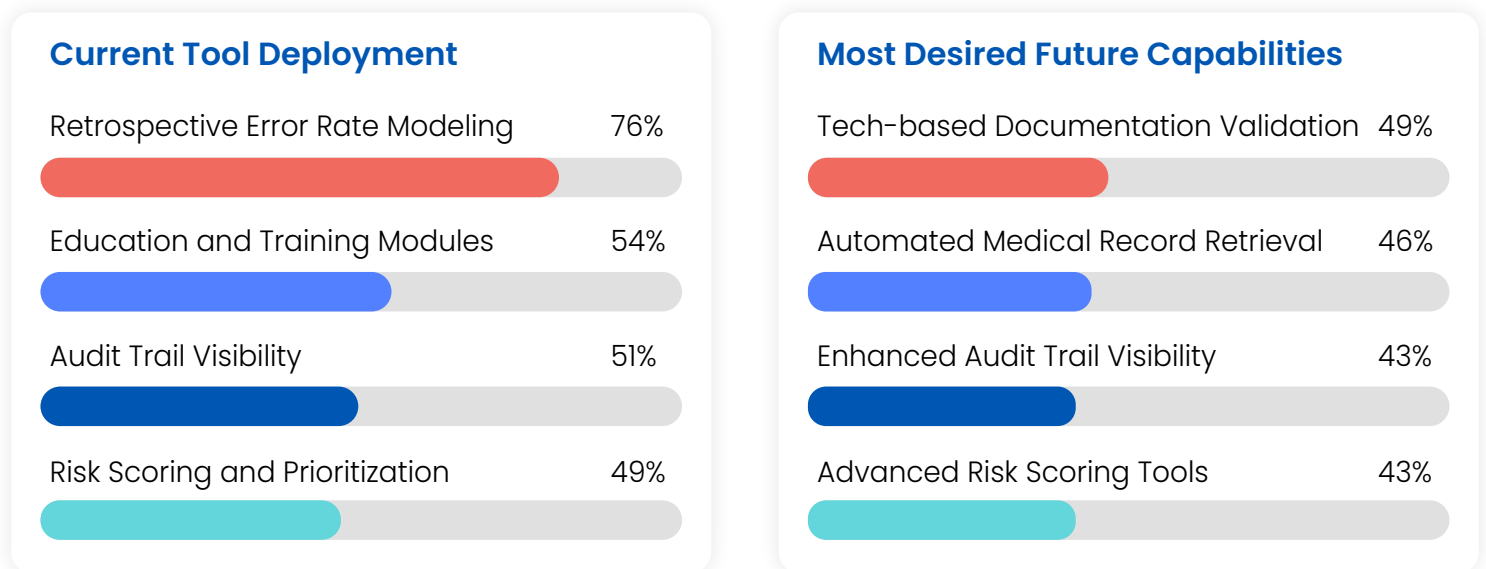
Analysis

Three-quarters of organizations acknowledge preparation deficiencies, with nearly two-thirds expressing low confidence in their ability to withstand RADV scrutiny.

Primary Audit Concerns & Challenges



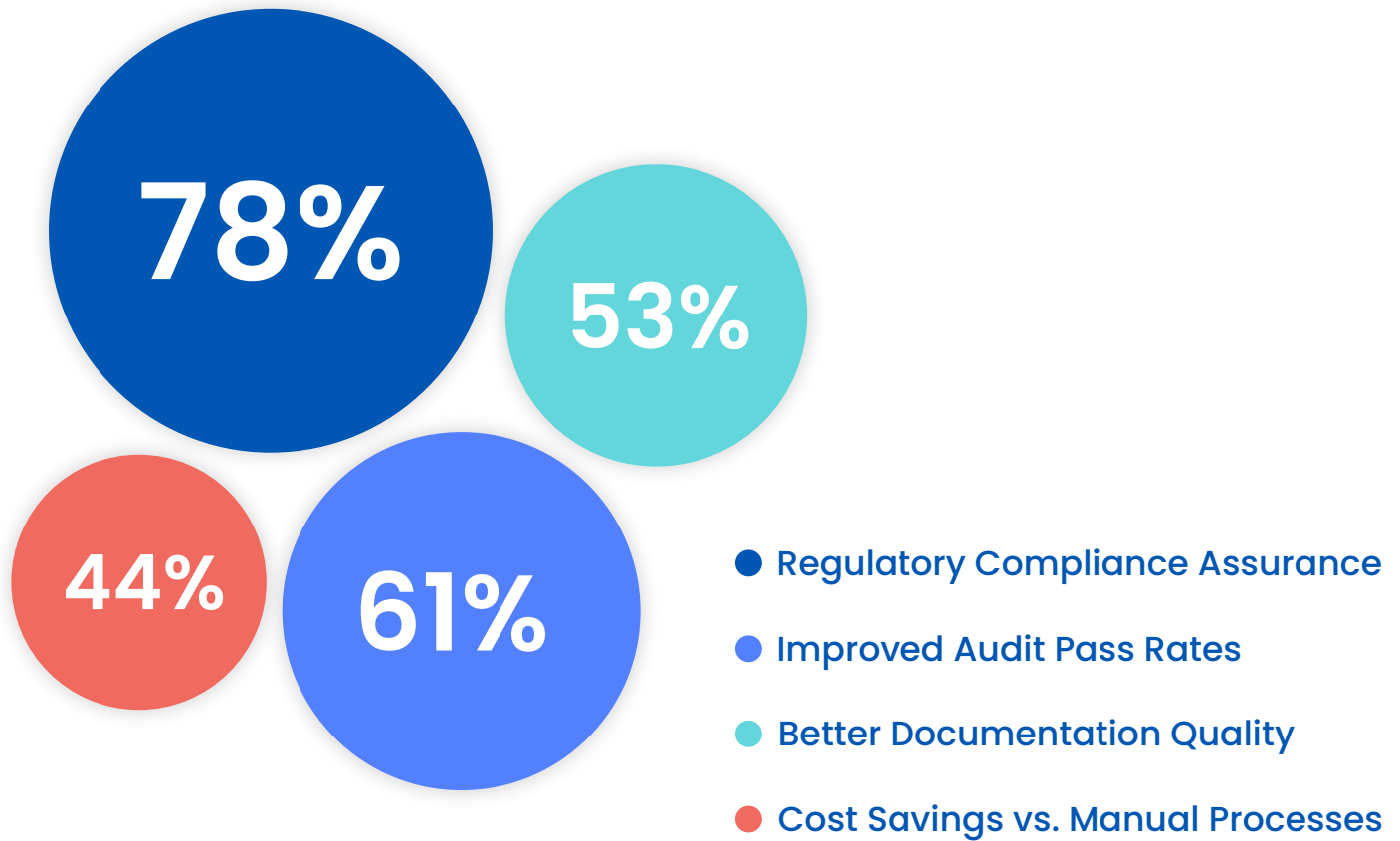
Technology Adoption Patterns



Analysis

Health plans fear audit penalties and strained provider relationships, with poor documentation being their biggest problem. While most currently use basic tracking tools, nearly half want smarter technology that automatically checks medical records and retrieves patient files, showing a clear move toward automated solutions.

| Strategic Recommendations

Immediate Action Plan (0-12 Months)

- ▶ Conduct comprehensive RADV risk assessment and gap analysis
- ▶ Establish dedicated audit response team with clear accountability
- ▶ Implement foundational provider education and monitoring programs
- ▶ Begin automated chart retrieval pilot programs



| Critical Success Factors

Technology-Enabled Transformation
